Sustainable mobility is a key driver for regional development, environmental protection, and improved urban liveability. In this context, the **Joint Training on Sustainable Mobility** aims to equip stakeholders with the necessary knowledge and skills to effectively plan, implement, and manage cycling mobility strategies.

The joint training on sustainable mobility aims to provide participants with technical and operational knowledge to promote sustainable mobility and tourism, with a focus on the Adriatic-Ionian cycle route. The program targets public sector staff and professionals in mobility and tourism, offering tools to improve cycling infrastructure, integrate with public transport, encourage bicycle use, and enhance tourism promotion.
